Maclay School encourages all students to be involved in community service for a number of reasons. Most important is the way that helping others enables young people to mature and broaden their worldview. Please note the following:

- 1. The Bright Futures Scholarship for Florida universities requires a minimum of 100 school-approved service hours during high school for their top award.
- 2. Community service is often a criteria of college admissions or of other scholarships/awards.
- 3. Juniors and Seniors interested in qualifying for the National Honor Society must have an AVERAGE of 36 hours per completed academic year. Therefore, a Junior candidate for NHS must have a total minimum number of 72 school-approved service hours typically by the beginning of September.
- 4. To join Anchor or Key clubs, candidates must also have an AVERAGE of 36 hours per completed academic year.

For school-approval of student's community service, the following criteria must be met:

- 1. The work must be unpaid, volunteer service which benefits one or more members of the community (typically working for a non-profit or at a community-based event.) Specific work for a for-profit company that directly benefits the community will count; please just describe the work with detail. ***Unpaid work that financially benefits a For-profit company or a family business is considered an internship or work-study, and not community service. ***
- 2. An adult supervisor must certify the hours. There are few exceptions to this rule.
- 3. Documentation certifying the hours must be presented to the Dean of Students. This must be on official stationery of the sponsoring organization, on a Maclay Community Service Record form, or originate from the organization's and/or adult sponsor's email.
- 4. Documentation must include the following:
 - 1. Date(s) of service:
 - 2. Total number of hours served;
 - 3. Brief description of type of work done;
 - 4. Organization name and the supervisor's printed name and signature (if not on supervisor's/organization's email.)
- 5. Enter the hours as a new record on the Portal.
 - 1. Select "Ecollect Forms" under "Navigation."
 - 2. Go to "Student Info" and select "Upper School Community Service Record."
 - 3. Previously entered records will be listed first. Scroll down to the bottom to enter a new record.
 - 4. After entering one record, select "Add Row" to enter more records or "Submit" to finish the process.

All students may turn in a hard copy of service hours to the Dean of Students at any time but are encouraged to keep a personal copy.
